Show and tell: Watch for a schedule, coming home this week!

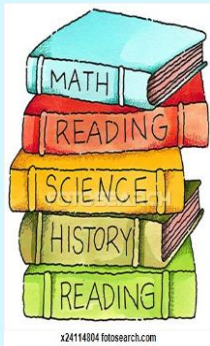
