Good day to the parents of grade 4 students.

Your child has the following homework/ tests this week:

Spelling words:

camouflage, predators, nectar, proboscis, nectar, pollinate, cycle, caterpillar, pupa, transformation, diversity, species, familiar. We are also reviewing two challenging words from last week: natural and immediate.

Our phonics rule is as follows:

A vowel is long when it says its own name. When a single vowel is at the end of a syllable, it usually is a long vowel, such as : pro bos cis, pu pa and cy cle..

We are studying adjectives and adverbs, as well as further study of the water cycle and clouds; in Social Studies, the games that children play (as part of our study of the effect of community and culture). In Bible, we look at the story of Noah's Ark and his faith and obedience.

Our Bible verses are : Genesis 9: 14- 15, as well as any verses for the week as found in the agenda(their choice).

Show and share will be held with children showing their favourite games, or games from another country. Please come on in and take a peek at their ongoing work on boards in the classroom, as well as the hall.
