Good day to all parents,

The following spelling words are to be tested on Friday, November 9th:

This focuses on the long A sound found in: a, a_e, ai, ay. ea, eigh, ey vowel combinations.

In Bible, tested on Friday, we will memorize the first two verses of the Lord's Prayer, studying the character of God and the nature of our prayers to Him. For better understanding of how to pray for others, we will begin a study of children and their faith and culture around the world.

In Science we will study the characteristics of the atmosphere, beginning with the nature of air.

In Social Studies our focus is on a comparison of the effect of our environment on our community and culture; from there to a study of the Stolo Aboriginal community in the lower Fraser Valley.

In English, we continue to read about the story of the survival of a young girl forced by circumstances to stay on an island when her tribe has been relocated; we will also work on the study of adjectives and adverbs to be used to increase speaking and writing skills.

In art, we will create wreaths that will reflect the international communities of Canada.
