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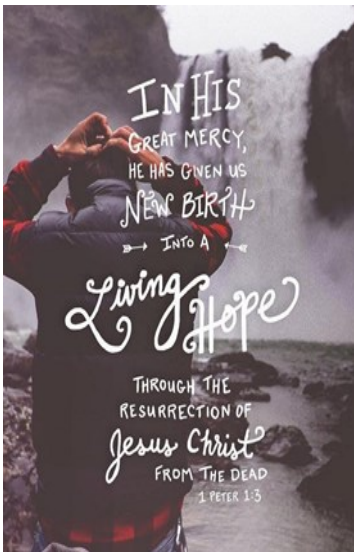

Good morning from grade four!

The following words will be tested on Thursday, November 22nd as the 23rd is a “day off” for your child. These words come from all the units that we have studied this far; I chose the ones that seemed to trip the students up. They will also need to know the phonetic rules that accompany the word. - believe, receive, chief, raise, waist, strain, quite, gone, these, huge, immediate, success, camouflage, diversity, species, safety, delay, deceive, says, eager.
