Good day parents!

Spelling—The following spelling words will be tested on Thursday, November 29th: (Hint: Many follow the “i” before “E” except after “C” rule.— icy, only, keys, yield, grief, chief, equal, valley, honey, sleepy, pieces, snowy, secret, beyond, monkey, believes, brownie, against, favourite

Spelling rules will be tested each week and each child needs to have their weekly rule memorized along with their spelling words.

Bible— Please make sure your child does the work sheet also included with their Bible verse (Psalm 23:1-3). It is in their BIBLE/SPELLING duotang.

Social Studies— There is a final Social Studies test on Friday, Nov 30, on the following information: definitions of culture and community, the environment and its connection to culture, the effect of our environment on our standard of living and how we eat, play and work. Also included is the Lower Fraser Valley salmon run and how the early Stolo people used their environment to live.

Christmas Concert—in preparation for our Christmas concert, we are looking for donations for thin 12X12” or larger cardboard, silver glitter or silver material and larger safety pins. If you have any of these items available we would be very appreciative if you could send them along. The children will be doing a very short play on Jesus’ birth and we will be asking each child to be able to provide their own costumes, which will be simple head coverings and long gowns or cloaks (brown or white), or long sleeved t-shirts with long skirts. We will have a short song, with a very few students having to memorize lines except for our song and silent night, which we will also practice in class.
