GRADE 1 - Ms. Riediger

- 1. Bible Memory: Psalm 27:1 is due on Thursday February 9: "*The Lord is my light and my salvation - whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life - of whom shall I be afraid?*"**
- 2. Sight Word Practice: The new list of words is unit 9 in the primer list. These words will be tested on Friday February 10: ran, but, pretty, so, what, that**
- 3. Spelling: Spelling words are on the orange paper in their agenda. Students will be tested on these words Friday February 10.**
- 4. Water Bottles: Students need to bring a water bottle to school every day.**
- 5. Language Arts: We are learning about friendly e who make vowels say their name in words such as: make, lake, bike, ride, hope, etc.**
- 6. Penguin Day: We have been learning about penguins. As an end to our unit, we will have penguin day this Tuesday February 7.
