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## **KINDERGARTEN - Mrs. Amendt**

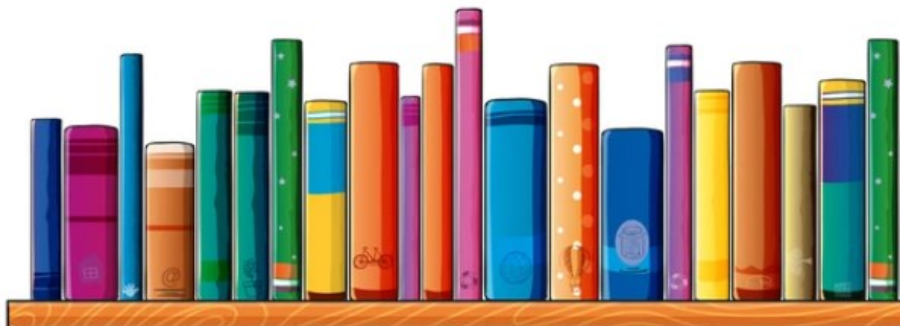
1. **Home reading will be sent home each day. Please read a few times with your child, initial reading log, and send both the book and reading log back to school on the next kindergarten day.**
