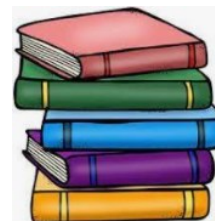
Sight Word Practice: Unit 3 words will be tested on Friday, September 27: down, my, big, in, jump

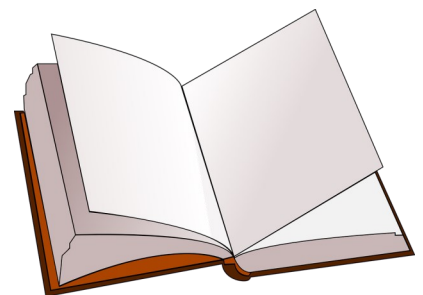
Memory Verse: Isaiah 12:2

Students should be finished chapter 5 and 6 questions by Wednesday, and chapter 7 by Friday.

Math: We are finishing working through rounding - making calculations of adding and multiplying using rounding to get close approximate answers. We will begin multiplication this week.

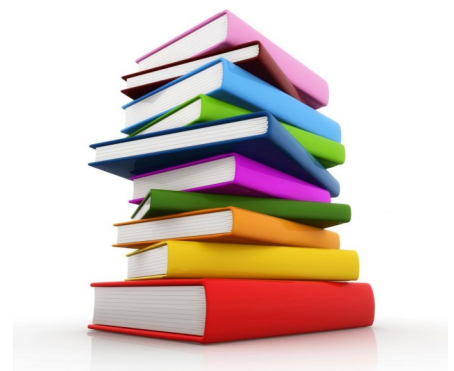
