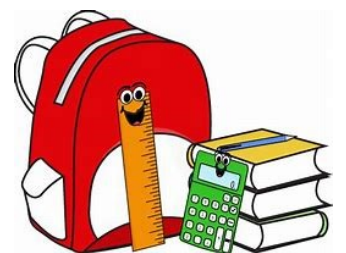

Dress Code

Some guidelines are as follows:

- **Shorts and skorts must not be shorter than mid thigh (between the start of the leg and the knee).**
