**Bible:** Wrapping up Abraham as we transition to Isaac this week and next.

**Social Studies:** We are beginning the Canadian Government units with a general overview of all three levels. Ask your child what the 3 levels of government in Canada are (Federal, provincial and municipal). They have learned a few things each level of the government is in charge of.
